Rhubarb adds a tart crisp edge to an English gin whilst the ginger warms for a full-bodied finish combined with Appletiser & fresh ginger.

Sharish Blue Magic **50ml** £14.40

This magic gin is made using the blue pea flower which turns pale pink when we add Mediterranean tonic water and mixed berries.

Solway Spirits Raspberry Gin Liqueur **25ml** £8.30
